

2026 Yamboree Parade Instructions

The School Parade is on Friday, October 16th, at 11 a.m.

All floats to be judged are to line up on Madison St., West of Titus. Floats to be judged need to be in position by 8:30 a.m. Float judging will begin at 9 a.m. All other Entrants that aren't being judged must be in place by 10 a.m. The parade will begin promptly at 11 a.m.

All entries other than the bands and floats being judged will need to enter at the corner of E. Redbud & Titus St. to be marked off the list by an official.

Bus parking will be on Madison St. between Hwy 271 and Titus Street. This street will be blocked off, but there will be a police officer or parade official there to let the buses go through to the parking area.

ALL AWARD WINNERS MUST PROVIDE TWO PEOPLE TO CARRY BANNERS IN THE PARADE.

Please bring your banner back to the Float Barns and give it to Tiffany de Gala, the Chairperson.

The Queen's Parade is on Saturday, October 17th, at 11 a.m.

Only floats to be judged must be on the Gilmer National Bank parking lot by 8 a.m., with everyone on the float by 9 a.m. Judging will begin promptly. All other entries must be in place by 10 a.m. There will be no cars allowed in the Gilmer National Bank parking lot.

All entries other than the bands and floats being judged will need to enter at the corner of E. Redbud & Titus St. to be marked off the list by an official.

PARKING INSTRUCTIONS

Entry to this area is off RedBud St. onto Railroad St. marked by a charity box. We will have a parade official there to assist you.

School buses only on Walker St. Buses will unload on Railroad St and can park there or they can go on to the high school.
